Supporting your Child

- 1. Ensure your child is properly prepared: kit, equipment, food, drinks etc
- 2. Encourage your child to have fun
- 3. Inspire your child to be the best they can be and let them know that their best is good enough
- 4. Ensure your child understands their Code of Conduct and the necessity of obeying rules
- 5. Endeavour to ensure your child is on poolside for the start of each session
- 6. Reply to all correspondence by the due date
- 7. Note the responsibility for your own child directly before and after a session
- 8. Be aware of and follow changing room rules, acknowledging that some venues have communal changing facilities

- 2. Support our Club by volunteering and participating in fundraising and committee events
- 3. Abide by acceptable use of mobile phones policy
- 4. Respect and applaud all athletes, not just your own child
- 5. Behave responsibly and respectfully towards swimmers, coaches, volunteers and parents at all times
- 6. Never use inappropriate language or behave aggressively towards any member at any time
